

ANZA's new project- Entry level 2018

Vineyard age: Average of 60 years old vines

Area: Rioja Alavesa

Towns: The grapes used for this wine come from 5 plots located in Elvillar and Laguardia.

Soils: Clay and limestone-based soils with high percentage of silt. Also, there is 10,4% of active chalk in its composition. The vineyards are located at the foot of Sierra Cantabria mountain range.

Altitude: From 560 m to 620 m depending on the parcel.

Varieties: Tempranillo, Graciano, Garnacha, Maturana, Viura and Malvasia.

Viticulture: Avoiding pesticides and using animal traction for the labour, minimizing soil compaction.

Method of production: The plots are vinified separately in open wooden tanks of 4000 litres and 500 litres barriques.

Ageing: 4000 litres wooden barrel and 500 litres French barriques. 12 months in used oak to maintain the vineyard's character.

Abv: 13,00%

Bottles produced: 8200

Harvest: From the 15th to 19th October. Hand harvested.
