Parcels Selection 2018

Parcels Selection (2nd wine): This wine shows the freshness and the typicity of the difference of towns from Bierzo.

Vineyard age: Average of 80 years old vines

District: Villafranca del Bierzo

Towns: Valtuille de Abajo and Otero

Soils: El Val de Valtuille (Clay base with gravel stones over the top), Otero (Slate and Clay).

Altitude: 540 metres aprox.

Varieties: Mencia, Alicante Bouchet, Souson and Doña Blanca.

Vineyard exposure: El Val (west), Otero (north), El Rapolao (west). All vineyards are located on hills.

Method of production: 2500 litres wooden used barrels. Post-fermentation maceration for 21 days on their skins and 60% stalk.

Ageing: 2800 litres wooden vats from France. 12 months ageing in used oak to maintain the vineyard's character.

Abv: 13,5%

Bottles produced: 5200

Harvest: From the 16th to 22nd of September. Hand harvested.
